 The 9th edition of the Vendée Globe race started on November 28th, 2020, with 33 sailors setting off from Les Sables-d'Olonne, France. Focus on the 8 participants who were unable to finish this voyage.

The Vendée Globe is a prestigious and grueling around-the-world sailing race that captures the imagination of sailing enthusiasts and adventurers alike. This solo, non-stop, and unassisted race demands the utmost skill, determination, and seamanship from its participants. One of the most remarkable aspects of the race is that each competitor embarks on this incredible journey alone, facing the immense challenges of the open ocean on their own. The race starts from Les Sables-d'Olonne, a picturesque coastal town located in the Vendée region of western France. From there, the sailors set off on their extraordinary odyssey, sailing through treacherous seas, enduring extreme weather conditions, and pushing themselves and their boats to the limits in pursuit of the ultimate prize — becoming a Vendée Globe champion.
